This year, Chutney Mary celebrates an impressive 35 years in business – and a decade in its elegant St James's home – with a special Chef's Gourmand Menu. When the restaurant first opened in 1990 in Chelsea, the idea of elevated Indian dining was still a novelty in the capital. But Chutney Mary helped redefine the genre, blending fine dining finesse with bold, regional flavours. Now, diners can toast its legacy with an indulgent multi-course menu featuring signature dishes like Mangalorean scallops, tandoori lobster and a rich lamb chop roghan josh. It costs £95 per person and, for those who want to go all out, an expertly matched wine pairing is available for an extra £50.
