Much-loved Indian restaurant Chutney Mary was named AA Restaurant of the Year London (2024) at a glittering function for more than 900 hospitality professionals at Grosvenor House.

The restaurant, which has been going for 33 years – 25 in Chelsea and eight in St James’s – was recognised for “delivering exceptional dishes with fantastic hospitality and service”.
